## **From the Desk of Fr. Pascual**

### **16<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Ordinary Time**

*"He who does justice will live in the presence of the Lord..."*

The verse quoted above is the response to our Psalm this 16<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Ordinary Time. It expresses how we can be acknowledged or even rewarded by our response to the call of God for us. We remind ourselves that God continues to call us to live as faithful sons and daughters. He invites us into His loving and forgiving presence. It is up to us whether to respond to his invitation or not. The lesson that the response expresses is that, he who does justice will live in the presence of the Lord.

Our response to His call can be varied. It can be demonstrated by our very act of kindness. Abraham in our First Reading showed that kindness through his hospitality to the three men. The same hospitality was also extended by Martha and Mary when they welcomed the Lord Jesus in their home. Though we may see a different scenario with the two sisters regarding their concern for the Lord, the story stresses more that every service, even service to Christ, cannot be separated from listening to the Word. The Lord clearly teaches Martha and all of us today that hospitality is expressed how we listen and live Christ in our day to day life. If we listen and live his Word we are able to determine right from wrong. If we are able to do that then we can start living justly in the presence of God.
