### **14<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time**

*“The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few...”*

## Good News from the Building Committee

Our Parish Hall construction documents have finally been approved by the City & County Department of Planning and Permitting (DPP). All DPP departments are satisfied with the documents and do not have any other concerns. We're moving forward to select our General Contractor. Thank you all for your patience and understanding. The permit application was submitted in October of 2008 and has been a challenge for us to coordinate and resolve all comments with the DPP.

The prints have been made available to the five potential General Contractors on June 25th. The GCs have a month to prepare and submit their estimates. Then the Building committee will screen the bids and make a selection. The contract will then be set and presented to the Diocesan Planning and Building Commission for approval.

Demolition and Construction are targeted to begin this October.

## From the Director of Religious Education

*CCD classes will begin on September 12, 2010*

**Registration for New CCD & New Confirmation Students:** will take place for the whole month of July **after all Sunday Masses**. There will be **no** registration on **Saturday**. You may also pick up a General Registration Religious Education form in the parish office from Monday-Friday, 8:00am-4:00pm. If you are receiving the sacrament of First Holy Communion or Confirmation, you must attach **copies** of both your Baptismal & Holy Communion certificates. Registration will be closed by July 31st.

**Returning Students:** All the registration forms that were distributed in May 2010 must be turned in to our Religious Education Office or placed in the blue container under the ushers table at the back of the church no later than July 31st.

**Those students attending Catholic School will have to attend Confirmation classes here at their home parish. The schools will not be preparing them for the Sacrament of Confirmation.**

Remember that if your child(ren) are receiving First Holy Communion or Confirmation, your family **must be registered parishioners**.
