DEDICATION OF THE LATERAN BASILICA IN ROME

Today marks the anniversary of the dedication of the cathedral church of Rome, on land owned by the Laterani family, by Pope Sylvester I (31 Dec.), 9 Nov. 324. Honored as the Episcopal seat of the pope as bishop of Rome, it is the “mother and head of all churches of Rome *caput*”); residence of the popes from the 4th c. until their moving to Avignon (1309); site of five ecumenical councils; dedicated to the Savior, later to John the Baptist. 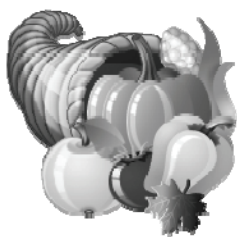
MORTGAGE WORKSHOP
